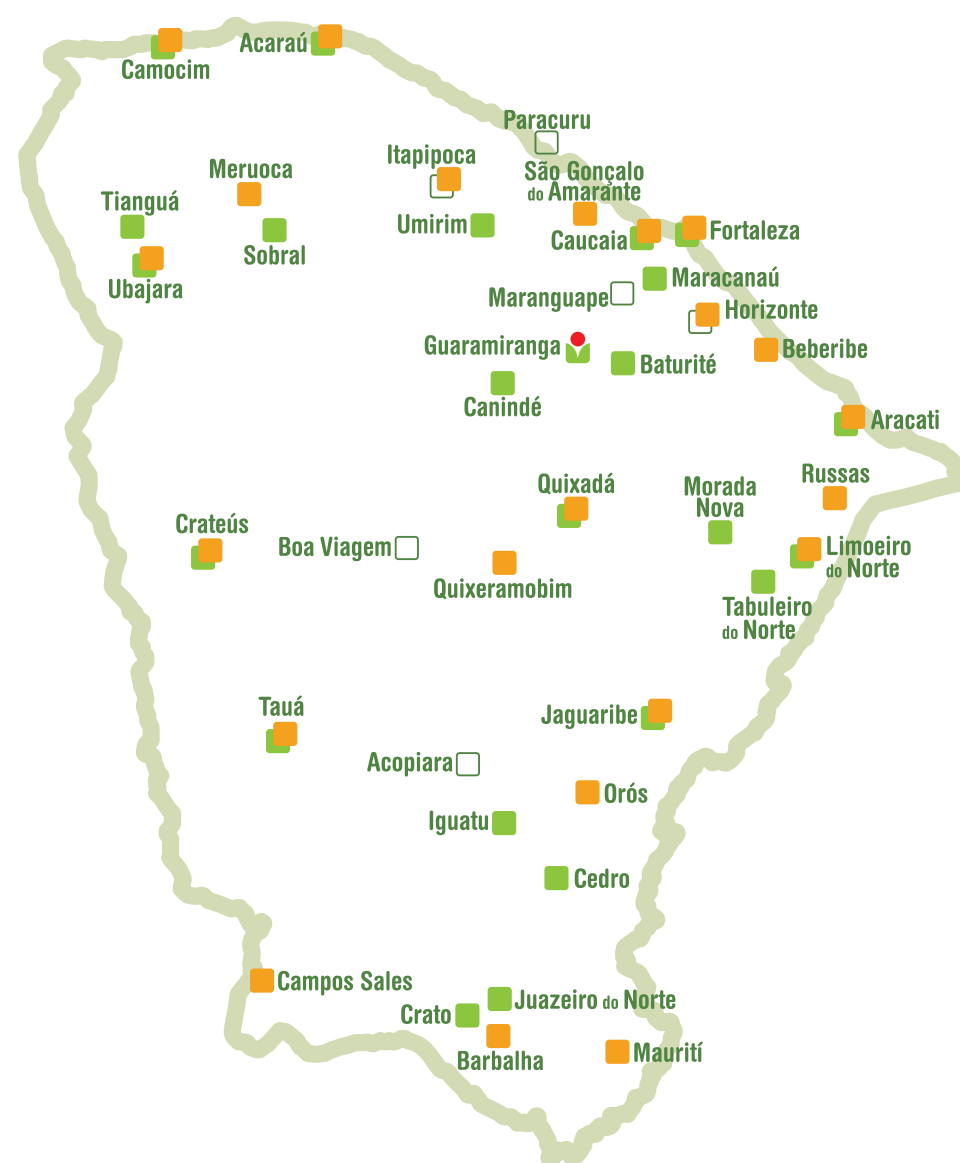

Who we are

The Federal Institute of Education, Science and Technology of Ceará is made up of 23 campuses, besides nine units being implemented, six conventional and three vocational education units (UEPs).

Focused on the promotion of the social and economic development of all regions in the State, IFCE offers vocational and technological education on several levels, through on and off campus programs always aiming the educational excellence.

The official foundation of IFCE happened in 2008, when the Federal Government established the federal network of vocational, scientific and technological network. Upon such initiative, the commitment to implement a vocational education policy for the country, which started in the first decade of last century, was consolidated.



IFCE principles

Mission – Produce, disseminate and apply the scientific and technological knowledge seeking to fully participate in the complete empowerment of citizens aiming their total social, political, cultural and ethical inclusion.

Vision – To become an excellent pattern of teaching, research and outreach in the science and technology field.

Values - In its activities, IFCE will value its ethical commitment with social responsibility, respect, transparency, excellence and determination in its actions according to the basic precepts of citizenship awareness and humanism, with freedom of speech, with the feelings of solidarity, with the innovation culture, focused on the environmental sustainability.



Academics

IFCE offers secondary technical programs (integrated, concomitant and subsequent to High School; education for youths and adults/EJA), higher-education programs (technological, bachelor's and teacher training degrees) as well as post-graduation programs (specialization, master's and inter-institutional doctorates), besides the initial and continuing education programs.

All the programs are focused on training a highly skilled labor force and empowering citizens to be fully able to fit properly in the labor market. Nowadays, the institution offers 88 secondary technical programs, 68 higher-education programs and 17 post-graduation programs, totalizing more than 20 thousand students.

How to be admitted

Secondary technical programs – New students who wish to join their secondary studies with technical empowerment or the ones who have finished High School shall apply to the entrance exams offered every semester.

Higher education programs – New students are selected through the Unified Selection System (Sisu) based on their Enem (National High School Exam) scores, except for those who apply to the art programs, which require an entrance exam and an assessment test on their specific skills.

Post-graduation programs – For the ones who hold an undergraduate diploma. The selection for those programs (specialization, master's and doctorate degrees) is carried out through public calls.

Initial and continuing empowerment programs – Short-term courses, focused on the update and empowerment of basic skills. Admission to those programs happens through specific selections.



Research

Just like the federal universities, the actions of the federal institutes comprise the academic, research and outreaching trinomial. Aiming to take new knowledge to the society and thereby improve people's lives, IFCE stimulates the creation of new technologies, the participation of students as researchers as well as the professors' academic production, with more than 90 research groups registered nowadays.



Outreaching

Outreaching seeks to integrate IFCE with the society through cultural, technological, sports and social activities, technological and social inclusion programs as well as the relationship with the business sector. It also includes the offer of initial and continuing education (FIC), the National Access Program to Technical Education and the Job Market (Pronatec), the Thousand Women Program, besides the Digital Inclusion Centers (CIDs) and Technological Information Nuclei (NITs).



Internationalization

IFCE has established successful partnerships in about 20 countries through exchange programs with important academic, research, outreaching, and scholarship granting institutions from the five continents. Local and foreign students and researchers are benefited by programs such as Science without Borders and International IFCE.



Students' affairs policy

The institution develops specific students' affairs policies, mainly related to issues such as residence, food, transport, culture, sports and pedagogical, psychosocial, medical and dental services. It also offers specific scholarships and grants with the purpose of ensuring the students' permanence and success in the institution as well as enabling their participation in academic events.
